Summer Camp Counselor Job Description

Organization

The Great Falls Rescue Mission (GFRM) is a Christian non-profit organization that has been serving the homeless in North Central Montana through emergency services and Christ-centered long-term recovery programs since 1963. GFRM partners with local churches to meet the spiritual needs of the people we serve. The GFRM Cameron Family Center provides a continuum of care specifically tailored to the needs of homeless families offering shelter, intervention, substance abuse recovery, Biblically based counseling/education, life skills development, with a view toward vocational training, employment and re-integration into the community.

Summary

The Summer Camp Counselor participates as a part of a team leading elementary age children and/or teenagers in a variety of summer day camp activities such as: worship, Bible lessons, crafts, games, outdoor activities and field trips. Summer Camp runs begins the first full week of June through the middle of August. This is a full-time, temporary and seasonal position with shifts that are Monday through Friday. Reports to the Family & Youth Program Director.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- Share the Gospel of Jesus Christ with the children by the example of your words and actions.
- Serve with a Christ-like character, demonstrating the Fruit of the Spirit in all interactions with children, youth, parents and other staff (Galatians 5:22-23).
- Maintain a fun and welcoming attitude for the children that attend daily.
- Lead age-appropriate class lessons, games, crafts and activities.
- Interact positively with children, parents, GFRM employees, volunteers, donors and the public.
- Communicate truth and practice integrity in all matters.
- Conduct self in a safe manner and help always maintain a safe working environment. Diligently ensuring the safety and welfare of the children under your care.
- All other duties as assigned.

Qualifications

- Have a solid Bible-based evangelical Christian faith which aligns with GFRM's Statement of Faith and core values.
- Member of or active in a solid Bible-based evangelical church.
- Valid Montana driver's license and insurable under GFRM's policy.
- Experience working with children and/or teenagers in a church, school or non-profit organization setting.
- Highschool graduate or equivalent – must be at least 18 years old.
- Must be able to pass an extensive background check.

Skills

- Committed to team participation and promote teamwork with your fellow camp counselors and other staff within the Cameron Family Center facility.
- Must be able to effectively multi-task and have good communication skills.
- Excellent people skills, with proven ability to encourage and motivate others.
- Teachable spirit and willingness to submit to leadership.
- Self-motivated, exhibiting responsibility, maturity, integrity, and dependability.
- Genuine burden to have people come to Christ.
- Able to counsel, based on Biblical truths and practical tools.
- Able to teach one-on-one and in a group setting.
- Must be an initiator who can work under deadlines.

Physical Demands

- Must be able to work indoors in an office setting or in a large activity room in addition to the outdoors in various weather conditions.
- Must be able to physically interact with children in indoor and outdoor activities.
- Lifting of up to 50 pounds may be required in addition to physical activity.

Software & Equipment

- Must be familiar with Windows, Microsoft Word, and Excel
- Must be familiar with basic office equipment, such as computers, copiers, and printers

Work Environment

This position will function to a large degree in a community environment. Part of normal duties for this position will include interaction with an at-risk population where errant behavior and disease risk may be present. Appropriate safety considerations will be required to avoid illness or injury.
