We've been blessed with an intern here at the mission; her name is Katie Maphies.



Katie and her brother were born and raised in Great Falls. She appreciates being in Montana since she loves snow skiing and spending time at her grandparents' ranch outside of Great Falls.

Katie started out her career as a hair dresser. That's where she learned that everyone has a story and

people frequently just need someone to listen. It's very theapeutic for them to share their stories.

Katie started volunteering at Great Falls Rescue Mission while still doing hair. She eventually decided to start school and study social work. She continued to volunteer at the Cameron Family Center working with the kids in the youth department.

Katie now works as a family activity supervisor. She comes along side families, helping parents as they reunite with their children. She also assists them in getting their identification and documentation in order to secure housing. This includes birth certificates, Social Security cards, IDs and just helping them navigate that, since it can be confusing.

Katie can relate to loss. Her mother passed away when she was only 7 years old. Her father passed away when she was 26 years old. She is blessed to have her grandparents living close for support. She empathizes with those who don't have family support.

Katie has seen a lot of success stories at the mission as they help families learn to live with structure instead of chaos.

Katie has been with the mission for three years now and has continued her studies in social work. She graduates this month with her bachelor's degree in Social Work (BSW) through the University of Montana.
